**Local Regulations:** NO U-TURNS are allowed within sight of either the start or the finishing points. Riders carrying out this dangerous manoeuvre are liable for DISQUALIFICATION from the event and further disciplinary action by the district committee.

**Northampton Police** stress that all competitors are made aware of the need for good behaviour and consideration towards other road users and local residents in order to avoid any complaints being received.

A working REAR LIGHT either flashing or constant, must be fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.

Hard-shell Helmets are recommended (Compulsory for under 18 year olds). In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard-shell Helmet that meets an internationally accepted standard

**Numbers:** These will be available at the Event Headquarters, not at the Start. Each number will have pins in each corner, please remove and place in box if not needed because you are using a NoPinz pocket. Also only use the corner pin holes and do not make more holes if using pins!

### Signing in/out:

Please ensure that you sign the "Signing-On" sheet when collecting your number and clearly call out your number when crossing the finish line.

Please ensure you return your number to HQ and sign-out, using the signing-on/off sheet. Failure to do so could result in your exclusion from the results.

### Covid-19 risk mitigation measures:

***There will be no push off so all riders must start with one foot on the ground.***

- Please maintain a sensible distance from the rider in front of you while waiting to start.
- Please bring your own pen to sign in/out if possible (pens and hand gel will be available at the signing on desk if required).
- Please do not stay at the signing on desk longer than necessary.
- Please use a face covering if entering the building to use the toilets.
- Unfortunately we are not offering after race refreshments this year but there will be a results board somewhere in the car park but please do not congregate around it.

**Doping Control:** This event may be subject to Doping Control. As soon as you have finished you should return to HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for a Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the results board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure you comply.

### Course Details: NC15B (20.8 miles) \*\* ALLOW 15 MINUTES TO RIDE TO START \*\*

<b>START</b>	On the Lamport to Rothwell Road, in line with the tree at junction to Draughton
<b>PROCEED</b>	North east towards Rothwell, past junction to Foxhall. Bearing right at junction to Harrington and continue to roundabout south side of bridge over A14 (4.83 miles) (M)
<b>ENCIRCLE</b>	Roundabout and retrace towards Lamport passing start to
<b>TURN LEFT</b>	At Manor Farm on entering Lamport (9.8 miles) (M) proceed towards Old to
<b>TURN LEFT</b>	At the junction opposite the White Horse pub (11.7 miles) (M) continue to the junction with the Foxhall/Broughton Road (13.77 miles) (M) where
<b>TURN LEFT</b>	And proceed westwards passing Mawsley and Foxhall Cottages to
<b>TURN LEFT</b>	At junction (16.72 miles) (M) and proceed towards Lamport
<b>TURN LEFT</b>	At Manor Farm on entering Lamport (19.11 miles) (M) proceed towards Old to
<b>FINISH</b>	In line with drain cover in the road near to the 'S-Bend' sign approx. 30 yards before the sign for old Village (20.8 miles).

### Road surface report:

In the main the road surface is OK as long as you ride on the "racing line" (at least 1m from the left hand edge of the road). However, the section "**westwards passing Mawsley and Foxhall Cottages**" does have 3 significant potholes (all reported so they may be fixed in time) and quite a few others close to the racing line so take great care on that section.
