Numbers and Signing On – Numbers will be at the Event HQ and can be collected when you sign on. Please return your number in exchange for a drink after your ride.

You MUST personally sign back in again upon completion of your ride otherwise YOU WILL receive a DNF!

Parking is available along the Sutton Lane and Granby Lane and throughout side roads within the village. Please be respectful to residents at all times - this means do not park across anyone's driveway and do not get changed into your Club kit in public unless you cover your modesty or lack thereof!

NO WARMING UP ON THE COURSE AFTER THE EVENT HAS STARTED! DO NOT OBSTRUCT THE PATH OF COMPETITORS WHO ARE GOING ALONG THE START OR FINISHING STRAIGHT - STAY ALERT!

COVID 19 REGULATIONS.

- If you feel at all unwell or are showing signs of Covid 19 DO NOT come to this event.
- Please avoid arriving too early or you may be asked to stay in your vehicle.
- Please wear a face covering when signing in/out and collecting and returning your number.
- There will be toilet facilities but these are not to be used as changing rooms.
- Please avoid gatherings in the car park. When signing on/signing out please maintain social distancing.
- Hand sanitisers will be available.
- Riders not adhering to the restrictions in place may not be permitted to ride and may be reported to CTT.
- These restrictions are not there to make it difficult for either you or the volunteers.



Instructions

Process to Start

To get to the start proceed west along Sutton Lane at the T-junction and turn right. Ride along Main Street in NNW direction and down the hill turning immediately left at the bottom of the hill into Barnstone Lane (unsigned). Proceed along Barnstone Lane over the little bridge and the start is further up on the right-hand side

Notes

IN THE INTEREST OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and Sherwood Cycling Club strongly advise you to wear a HARD-SHELL HELMET that meets internationally accepted safety standards. It is now compulsory that you have a working rear light, either flashing or constant, that is fitted to the machine and is active whilst the machine is in use.

Do not stop at the finish timekeeper but proceed straight ahead up Granby Hill retracing your steps back to the Village Hall. Do not congregate at the finish.

Please allow at least 10 minutes from the HQ to the start. It is 2.5 miles from the HQ.

Please ride carefully, especially when merging onto the A52 at Granby Lane end and again at Bottesford.

Please do not warm up on the course after the event has started. Strictly NO U-Turns near the start and finish between 9:00am. – 11:00am.

Marshals are instructed to report dangerous riding so keep your head up and be considerate of other road users.

DO NOT WARM UP PAST THE START TIMEKEEPER AS THIS MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.

This event may be subject to doping control.

As soon as you have finished, you should return to the HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for testing.

Race numbers required for doping control will be displayed adjacent to the result board.

Remember, you are required to return to the HQ to sign back in again after finishing your ride.

Please remember to give thanks to all Marshals and Club members, without who, this event would not be possible.

The Lighthouse Cafe at Gunthorpe from the early 1950's. It was the owners of the cafe that donated the Lighthouse Trophy to the ANDCC (Association of Nottingham and District Cycling Clubs). The trophy is still raced for every September and is currently held by us. Any Nottingham and District Club is currently entitled to win the trophy. It should be renamed the "Poisoned Chalice" trophy as winning it means you are obliged to promote and run the event the following year and every subsequent year until you lose...

The building is still there and is now a restaurant called The Bay Tree.
