Proceed to Wheatsheaf island A570 Rainford Bypass and turn left (1.691m) Proceed to M58 island -care- and encircle (3.353m) Straight across Wheatsheaf island and proceed to Rainford island (6.98m) and retace back on A570 to Wheatsheaf island (8.736m) Left along Lodge Lane / Intake Lane to finish at second gatepost on edge of plantation (10.035m)						
Headquarters(open from 12:30) at the layby adjacent to A570, 100m from the start at the top of Intake Lane. Complaints could lead to the course being banned. Park in Ormskirk Road by all means but down away from the houses, or at the HQ at the football club.
