Course M26 (26 Miles (Hilly) Course Record - C.Donaldson (GS Metro) 57:36 - (2016)

Belsay - Hartburn - Rothley Crossroads - Scots Gap - Belsay


Start at Belsay on minor road 200 metres north of the junction with the A696 and B6524. Proceed north on minor road via Bolam Lake to junction with the B6343 (6.4 miles). Turn right on the B6343 through Hartburn to Dyke Neuk. Turn left on minor road and continue to T-junction. Turn left on minor road to Rothley Crossroads. Turn left on minor road to Scots Gap. Turn left in Scots Gap on the B6343, then first right on minor road in the direction of Belsay to Finish, opposite the start.


Please Note

Numbers and sign on are at Whalton Village Hall - Please show consideration for residents when in the village. Changing facilities and toilets are in the Hall.

Also - The start is 3 miles from the Headquarters - so allow ample to ride to the start

Course details





Safety notes:

* Vehicles of competitors / officials / marshals / helpers to be parked safely and without hindrance to other road users.

Riders:

- * Riders take extra care at T-junctions, at right hand turns, on steep descents with bends, through lightly built up area of Hartburn. This includes no cutting of corners!
- * No U-turns to be made in the vicinity of the timekeeper.

In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

All competitors under the age of 18 years and/or Juniors must wear a properly affixed helmet that conforms to recognised standards.

It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

IMPORTANT

Rules regarding Right hand turns are in place for this event. Scots Gap has TWO such turns - outward leg and return. We have nearly had accidents - not from cars, but riders hitting riders!!

Marshalls will be making note of dangerous and reckless CORNER CUTTING at this junction and this will lead to INSTANT DISQUALIFICATION. No leeway.

The organisers decision is FINAL

On the return leg, please expect to lose approx 5 seconds or so by slowing down, braking, and taking this corner legally and SAFELY. The seconds lost will be worth far less than skin, bike damage and prizes due to an accident ordisqualification.

We have seen some very near misses. YOU HAVE ALL BEEN WARNED!!!

BOLAN LAKE SECTION

IThe stretch of road alongside Bolam lake is VERY potholed and rutted. Mainly on the outward leg. NO head down riding or riding down the middle of the road. Please be vigilant, pick a safe line and be aware of the dangers. A Marshall will be here to remind riders of the poor surface.

WHALTON VILLAGE

Whalton is now a 20mph zone, so please keep warp speed warm ups outside of the this 20 zone to avoid any complaints from the locals. Thank you.

The fourth running of the Andy Mallen Memorial Time Trial in memory of my younger brother, Andrew (32) who tragically died in a cycling accident in the Alps July 2015. Andy was a member of GS Metro since its rebirth in 2006 and competed in time trials regularly, with mixed success and fortune! He was a much liked member of the club, liked by everyone and didn't have a bad word to say about a soul. "True Gent" are the words oft used. His claims to cycling fame were notably and amusingly - coming 6th in the Hartside Hill Climb and winning a prize (they got his time VERY wrong) - "Dont worry, they will amend it when results come through the post" I said. They didn't and there his name was in Cycling Weekly!! And lastly - he once 'won' the 'Residents Choice' prize donated by the residents of Eastgate near Prudhoe at our Hill Climb for being 'The happiest looking, smilingest competitor' and it's with such fondness that we remember Andy and this event will continue to keep him in our hearts and thoughts.


