Course: J2/9

START at a JS2 mark in Bomish Lane (Badger Bank to Goostrey road) at telegraph pole no.2 approx. 300yds west of the A535. Proceed east to the A535 and forward on the A535 to :

Chelford Island (2.169 mls) where 2nd exit left onto the A537 to Seven Sisters Lane at:

Ollerton Cross-roads (5.219 mls) where left along the lane to the A50 and left at Twemlow Lane at:

Cranage (11.408 mls) where left into and along the lane to join the A535 at Twemlow Green, left to:

Chelford Island (18.064 mls) where 2nd exit left onto the A537 to Seven Sisters Lane, left along the lane to join the A50, left again to:

FINISH (25.000 mls) at the J2/9 mark opposite the right-hand field gate post, opposite and just before the entrance to the Mount Pleasant Nursing Home.

Invitation event and Combined Prizes – explanatory note The open event is an invitation event, in that the ladies who are riding the ladies' event can 'invite' or nominate one of the riders in the open event to be their teammate for the combined prizes. In practice, some ladies do not do this, and some open event riders have not been nominated. To try and make sure that there is some competition for the combined prizes the organiser has matched up any 'spare ladies' with unallocated open riders. For this event, ladies have been matched with open riders from their club, where possible.

Notes and Local Regulations

The Risk Assessment document will be available at Signing-On.

Care at road junctions

Riders must exercise care at all junctions. Any competitor whose riding line causes him/her to cross the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.

Chelford Island

Riders must negotiate Chelford Island in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg. 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this. Riders **MUST NOT USE** their tri-bars between the first bollard they pass on entering the island and the last bollard they pass leaving it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.

Remember – traffic on the island has priority over traffic (including riders) entering it.

Vehicles

A competitor must not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in any way receive assistance from a motorised vehicle or its occupants during events shorter than 100km (CTT Reg 22).

No parking for riders or spectators at the start or finish. Vehicles must not be parked, however briefly, in any part of the access area of Mount Pleasant Nursing Home, opposite the finish. **Parking is available at the headquarters, please be considerate towards local residents.**

Safe riding

Riding with your head down such that you do not have a good view of the road ahead is dangerous - please watch out for potholes, obstacles, and other road users.

Marshalls do not have the authority to control other road users, so please take care.

Start and finish

No “U” turns in the vicinity of the start or finish.

Riders must not stop at the finish, but should instead continue back to the headquarters.

No parking for riders or spectators at the start or finish. **Parking is available at the headquarters, please be considerate towards local residents.**

Helmets

All competitors **MUST** wear a properly affixed helmet of hard/soft shell construction that meets international standards.

Front and Rear Lights

No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, and to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, each of which shall be either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

Road Bike Criteria

The road bike can possess drop or straight handlebars; no tri-bars, clip-on bars or Spinaci bars are allowed; no disc wheels; both front and rear wheels must have at least 12 spokes each; the maximum rim depth allowed is 90mm.

Helmets used in Road Bike category events must not cover the ears or have a teardrop/pointy style “tail”, any helmet vents must not be covered or blocked. The helmet must not have been altered or had any element added or removed in terms of design or form but may be used as the manufacturer's intended (e.g., sliding vents). It is prohibited to add a detachable cover to a helmet. The composition of the helmet material and its surface condition are not subject to any regulations. However, additions to the helmet are not allowed (cover, tape etc).

N.B. For competitors riding Road Bikes, competitors must predominantly ride holding the drops or brake hoods. Riders may not ride in the “Puppy Paws” Position or simulate a Tri-Bar position by resting the forearms on the handlebars.

Each year, the M&DLCA awards several prizes and trophies to members of the M&DLCA and affiliated clubs. Clubs can affiliate by sending £10 affiliation fee to Mavis Ross, details are on our website on the affiliation form. Any event on a ‘25’ or ‘50’ mile ‘J’ course counts for these trophies, as long as copies of the results sheet and entry form are sent to the M&DLCA BAR Secretary, K. Jackson, but the only counting ‘10’ mile events are the two organised by the M&DLCA plus the 10 mile event on 23/03/2024 run by the M&DTTA.
