at The Normandy Centre, Denne Road, Horsham RH12 1JF and it is hoped that the winners will be able to attend.

Please note the following points :

- Numbers will be available at the HQ which will be open from 7:00am. **You must sign on before** collecting your number and note the details of any special hazards on the course which will be displayed there.
- **You must also now sign out** when returning your number after your ride. **Fail to do so and you will be shown as DNF**
- **London South District regulation** - No vehicles, except those of the timekeepers and event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the starting and finishing areas.
- Competitors are requested not to warm up on any part of the course after the first rider has started.
- Riders must not cross the A22 in the vicinity of the start and finish areas.
- There are a number of roundabouts on the course and riders must exercise extra care, giving way to traffic from the right.
- No times given at the finish. They will be on the result board at the HQ where you can exchange your number for a drink.
- CTT regulations require the compulsory use of a protective cycle helmet by riders aged under 18 in time trials. In the interests of your own safety Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise all competitors to wear a hard/soft shell cycle helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.
- It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to your cycle in a position where it is clearly visible to following road users and is switched on for the duration of your ride in the event.
- Responsibility for taking the correct route rests with each rider, so please read the course details. Where marshals are positioned on the course they indicate the direction to be taken by riders but do not control the flow of traffic or indicate that it is safe for the rider to proceed. Please take care whilst riding and avoid becoming another accident statistic.


CAR PARKING

There is only limited space for cars to park in the area in front of Fairwarp Village Hall.
Once this is full please only park on the left-hand side of Nursery Lane beyond the Hall and do not park in or obstruct the track which goes straight ahead at the right-hand bend. You can use the verge on the left-hand side of the road after the bend for additional parking. **Do not do anything which might annoy the local residents** as our future use of the Village Hall for the HQ is at risk if we get complaints.

Proceed to Batts Bridge roundabout and take 2 nd exit (straight on). At Black Down roundabout take 2 nd exit (RIGHT) to follow the Uckfield by-pass via Copwood roundabout. At Little Horsted roundabout take 2 nd exit (straight on) via the Golf Course and Halland roundabouts to the Shaw roundabout.	0.00	0.00
