Event dedication: Pete Read and Team Swift

I enjoyed chatting to Yorkshire coaching legend (that is not too strong a word) Pete Read at Hatfield events, generally with riders from his Team Swift club doing extremely well as we all know. Pete passed away since the last Rossington event was held and I would like to give a nod to the considerable positive influence he and his team (including the other Team Swift management members) had on the Yorkshire time trialling scene by dedicating this event to Team Swift and Pete's memory.

Special Covid 19 guidance:

- Any rider, supporter or member of the organising team who believes they could be demonstrating symptoms of Covid 19, are currently in a vulnerable group required to selfisolate, or have been told to self-isolate should not attend the event.
- Riders are strongly encouraged not to attend with any supporters unless necessary, such as if the rider does not drive.
- Face masks should be brought and used by riders when signing on/off. Those requiring safety pins for their numbers should bring their own. After competing, used numbers should be placed in the bucket with detergent provided.
- Riders and any supporters should not socialise with others either before or after the
 event: riders should arrive in sufficient time to sign on, compete, and then go home after
 signing off. No results will be provided at the event but will appear by way of the internet
 after the event.

Other quidance:

- In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the Event Promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard-shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.
- Standard hard-shell hats must be worn by juniors and under 18s.
- *** It is now compulsory that a rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is 'on'/ working at the start of the event. ***
- This event may be subject to a Doping Control. It is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for any Doping Control will be displayed at the signing on/ off point. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If your number is displayed you are required to report to Doping Control, which will be nearby, after finishing and without delay.
- All competitors are now required personally to sign the signing out sheet when returning their number. Failure to do will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF.

Course description:

O25/11. Start on A18 at north end of lay-by approximately ½ mile north of Hatfield Green Tree Public House:

- Proceed to Tudworth TI (0.413)
- Take 2nd exit on A18 to Crowle TI (6.678)
- Encircle island (Give way to traffic from left twice) and retrace to Tudworth TI (13.005)
- Left on A18 to Green Tree Public House (13.995)
- Left on A614 to Blaxton TI (20.102)
- Encircle island and retrace towards Hatfield Woodhouse to finish just past first lamp post approximately 100 yards after Hatfield Woodhouse sign (25.000)

Note the following (both require extra care):

- Crowle turn is not a conventional island. For a start, don't take the turning towards Belton
 (as some poor chap did last time). You double back to go back down the road you came
 down (back past the windmills).
- *****Blaxton TI is small and oval (it's an 'oblongabout'!). Don't be its latest victim ****

Please note:

- Keep your head up at all times
- At the START riders MUST NOT stand in the roadway.
- After finishing riders should not stop but continue to event HQ.
- No U turns WHATSOEVER within sight of the start or finish.
- No warming up on the course after the event has started.
- No Parking by anyone connected with the event on Ancient Lane
