- (8) U Turns (see note below)
 - "U turns will not be permitted on courses or roads adjacent to start / finish areas whilst a race is in progress". NOTE: Any breaking of this Regulation in the first case may mean disqualification from the event. Further cases will be referred to the District Committee. A U-Turn is defined as a 180-degree turn completed within the width of the carriageway whilst astride the machine. It is recommended that the rider(s) should dismount, check the road is clear in both directions then with machine walk across the road.
- (11) Numbers and signing in/out sheet will be at HQ and NOT at the start, please ensure that you sign-on when you collect your number, please return your number for a free drink after the event.
 Attn. All competitors Please note that for 2017 all competitors are now required to PERSONALLY to the sign out sheet when returning the number. Failure to do will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF.
- (12) Warming up: No riding along the course by competitors once an event has started.
- (15) Earsham Village Hall: This regulation must be printed on the start sheet for all events using this venue.
 - 1) NO CAR PARKING
 - a. In the private driveway next to the Village Hall
 - b. At the nearby bus stop
 - c. At the road junctions in the vicinity of the Village Hall.
 - 2) INAPPROPRIATE CONDUCT

To retain the use of this Hall any behavior that might cause offence, e.g. loud noises such as the banging of car doors, indiscreet changing of clothing in the vicinity of residential area, etc. must be avoided.
