Course Details. A25/11 (REVISED 2019):

- Start at lighting column no. 105138 by field gate on A5132, Hilton.
- Proceed to roundabout where turn left up slip road to join A50 westbound.
- Across THREE roundabouts (Sudbury, Uttoxeter Racecourse, McDonalds)
- Take slip road at JCB interchange.
- At roundabout at top of slip road turn right, crossing the A50 to next roundabout where turn right to take slip road onto A50 eastbound. (CARE: ROAD TURNS BACK ON ITSELF).
- Re-join A50 (12.5 miles).
- Retrace on A50 eastbound, across THREE roundabouts
- Take slip road A516 Derby West.
- At Willowpit roundabout take second exit onto A516 to finish approximately 50 yards after right hand turn signposted Etwall.

AFTER FINISHING: NO U-TURNS ON A516. EITHER CONTINUE TO TURN LEFT INTO ASHE LANE OR TO ROUNDABOUT WHERE TAKE THIRD EXIT TO RETURN TO ETWALL VILLAGE

Directions to the start from HQ:

The start is approximate 1.5 miles from the HQ, from the car park follow signs for the A50, at Willowpit island proceed straight over the two roundabouts.

Due to the nature of the start area, a holding pen for waiting riders will be operational, strictly 3 riders only behind the timekeepers, **ALL** other riders should wait at the starting pen. Please do not warm up on the course, there is a variety of roads close to the start to use for warming up. **STRICTLY NO PARKING AT THE START.**

Event HQ.

Frank Wickham Hall, Portland Street, Etwall. DE65 6JE.

Parking:

Parking is strictly restricted at the HQ for race officials, disabled badge holders and para cyclists only.

Competitor parking is available at John Port School (opposite Spread Eagle PH) which will be

signposted. Note the car park is one way, starting from the south entrance. Upon arrival you will be directed to an appropriate parking space relative to your vehicle size, please park considerately and do not leave space for gazebos and turbo trainers, there will be sufficient space for turbo trainers behind your parking space. You will be asked to move your vehicle if occupying multiple spaces.

DO NOT PARK IN EITHER PORTLAND STREET OR THE ACCESS DRIVE TO THE VILLAGE HALL.

The quickest way to the HQ is back through the car park main entrance, across the road and cut through the park, alternatively to walk turn into Wellington Road (next to Spread Eagle PH), then immediately right into Portland Street. Continue up the hall drive, over speed bumps. The hall will be open from 1400 hours Saturday and 0500 hours Sunday. NO CYCLING SHOES IN THE HALL.

Race Numbers:

Will be available at the HQ and will be issued after signing-on. In accordance with Championship Conditions only numbers provided by the organizer should be used. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16 and Arm Numbers should be fitted to the upper arm with the number facing forwards (not inwards). Riders must also sign out at the end of the event. Failure to do so will result in a DNF.

Awards:

The presentation will take place as soon as possible after the event has finished. Please make every effort to stay and applaud the prize winners.

IN THE INTEREST OF YOUR OWN SAFETY. Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly recommend that you wear a hard-shell helmet. Riders under 18 MUST wear a hard-shell helmet. We also recommend, even in strong sunlight, the use of a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
