Course

10 mile, A10/16. Start : On A6 by lamp post T55798, north of Church Lane, Darley Dale. No cars to be parked in this lay-by. Riders must stay within the confines of the lay-by and not spill out onto the road. A maximum of 8 riders can be accommodated in this lay-by. (This is also the start of the A25/12)

Go north along the A6, pass through Rowsley and continue to Bakewell. Carefully encircle the island - it is much smaller than you think! Return along the A6 through Rowsley, past the start to finish by a white mark, just north of Whitworth Road, Darley Dale and about 200m before the Grouse.

In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event secretary strongly advise you to wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard and have a rear light attached to your bike.
