Fifteen-mile events are something of a novelty for us in the South Wales district, this being the only one on the 2022 calendar, but we've chosen a track that offers a good chance of a PB as the route includes the relatively-quick R10/17 course with a couple of miles added on at either end.

First to start will be tandem riders Andrew LEGGE and Joanna KNIGHT from the Bristol South Cycling Club, followed by clubmate Daniel KEMPE. We're delighted to also have a trike rider with us this week in Wayne BAKER (Team Echelon). Our field of forty concludes with previous VCC event winner Owen BURGESS (UF Rowe & King) and finally the (male) course record holder Christopher GIBBARD (Bynea Cycling Club).

THE 15/5 COURSE

- Start on B4598 opposite bus stop lay-by for The Hardwick public house (NP7 9AA), in between T-junction with side lane and gateway to farm buildings.
- Proceed north-westwards toward Hardwick roundabout, (0.87 miles).
- Take 1st exit left onto A40 towards Raglan roundabout.
- Encircle Raglan roundabout (8.7miles) taking 5th exit left onto A40 westbound back towards Abergavenny.
- After A40 bends from west to north-west, finish at joint #271 in entrance splay of next lay-by, 15.011 miles.

There will be marshals stationed at key points around the course but please remember that they're there for guidance only and have no authority to control traffic. Please take the time to familiarise yourself with the course and take particular care at the Raglan roundabout where several roads converge:

AWARDS

There are no monetary prizes on offer at this event as it was originally registered as part of the Celtic Series for 2022 – the intention being that riders would instead earn points in a season-long championship. This is no longer the case, so instead we've divided the field into three groups and will award the fastest rider in each group a free place in our 25-mile event over on the R25/7 course in August (or the option of transferring it to 2023 if preferred).

The groups are based on Spindata rankings, meaning that riders are matched against others with similar recent form -- regardless of their age, gender or preference for faster/slower courses.

The groupings will be announced when the Spindata rankings are updated on Wednesday July 13, so please re-visit this document as the event draws nearer.

REMINDERS FROM THE SOUTH WALES DISTRICT

All riders are asked to comply with the following.

- Please call your number to the finishing timekeeper otherwise your time may not be recorded.
- Please keep your head up, be aware of your surroundings and HAVE A SAFE RIDE.
- It is now a **requirement** (no longer just a recommendation) that riders have FRONT AND REAR lights, either flashing or constant, fitted to their machines in a position visible to other road users.
- This event may be subject to doping control. It's YOUR responsibility to check.
- Sign in AND sign out; technically you haven't finished the event until you've signed out.
- Please don't pass the start timekeeper or warm up on the course. There's plenty of space for a warm-up if you head northbound from the HQ; just keep an eye on the clock!
- Don't use a turbo trainer within 100m of residential areas.
- Failure to follow these basic rules will result in a disqualification and referral to the South Wales DC for further disciplinary action.
