
We look forward to seeing you back at the HQ afterwards for some well-earned tea and cake!

Event HQ

The Event HQ is St Botolph's Community Hall, Grantham Road, Sleaford, NG34 7NW which will be open for signing on from 1pm. <https://what3words.com/form.decreased.universally>

We would like to take this opportunity to ask that you do not park in front of the Event HQ and instead use the car park on Grantham Road. We would like to continue to use St Botolph's Church Hall for future events and for this reason we need to make sure we don't upset the local residents!



Directions:

From the A15/A153 roundabout take exit to Sleaford. HQ is approximately 1 mile on the left.

Course Details

To get to the start from Event HQ go right towards Grantham. Take the first exit at Quarrington roundabout onto the A15. The start is approximately half a mile along on the left.


C10/10: Start on A15 Sleaford Bypass 0.25 miles South of Quarrington Roundabout (A15/A153/B1517) near field entrance with large tarmac entrance both sides of A15. Proceed South on A15 through Osbournby to Roundabout (A15/A52). Encircle Roundabout and retrace along A15 to Finish approximately 80 yards short of lay-by sign (approximately 1 mile going south) and 0.32 miles short of the Start.

Rules and Regulations

Numbers

These will be issued when signing on and must be returned when signing back in (Reg. 17b).

The number shall be centrally positioned below the rider's waist, so as to be clearly visible from the rear when in his/her normal riding position.



Restrictions.

There must be no warming up on the course once the event is in progress.

U turns are not permitted in the vicinity of the Start and Finish areas.

No head/earphones are permitted, except for hearing aids (Reg. 19).

Please call your number out upon completing your ride and continue to the HQ.

Please remember to sign back in.

Regulation 14

(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

Regulation 15

All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard
