Headquarters: Crathorne Reading Rooms. Unfortunately, there is no parking available at the HQ. Please do not park in Crathorne Village as it causes obstruction to large heavy agricultural vechicals. For parking, please use the lane leading to the Rountons over the A19.

- i) If you feel unwell on the day or days leading up to the event, please do not travel to the event, please stay at home.
- ii) All numbers are available at the Event Headquarters. All riders will be required to sign on, when collecting their number. A notice will be on display, adjacent to the signing on sheet, identifying any significant risks that may have been identified on the day of the event, which may affect the rider's or official's safety.
- iii) Each rider must sign out at the completion of their ride, when returning their number. Failure to sign out will result in a DNF being recorded in the results.
- iv) The HQ has been so organized for riders to enter the building through the front door, sign on at table & collect their number and exit through the back door. If you require the toilet, turn right before exiting and the toilets are on the left and straight ahead.
- v) On returning to sign out, please leave your number in the provided box, so they can be washes & sanitized before their next use.
- vi) The HQ has been so organized for riders to enter the building through the front door, sign on at table & collect their number and exit through the back door. If you require the toilet, turn right before exiting and the toilets are on the left and straight ahead.
- vii) Please do not congregate at the HQ and leave after signing out & number return.
- viii) If a dope control has been established for the event, notices will be displayed local to the signing out sheet indicating the numbers of the riders to be tested. It is the rider's responsibility to check whether his number is listed, as failure to report to the control in a reasonable time could result in an adverse finding being recorded against a competitor, with the consequence of a ban being issued.
- ix) No cars other than the Event Officials are to be parked at the start or finish
- x) No U turns are to be undertaken within sight of the start or finish.
- xi) Riders are not to warm up on any part of the course, whilst an event is being held.
- xii) Under Covid19 Guidance, please do not use turbo trainers.
- xiii) In the interest of your own safety, hard shell helmet use is recommended for all competitors.
- xiv) A red rear working light must be affixed to a competitor's cycle at the start. No light = No Ride
- xv) In common with other events during the current restrictions, there will be no pushing off. Riders will be start with their foot on the ground.

Course: T102: Start at grating on east side of old A19, 40 yds north of post at gateway, approx 350 yds south of Crathorne village. Proceed south to join A19 southbound. Continue to Cleveland Tontine Hotel (4.98 mls) and turn sharp left and left again (care) onto A172 Stokesley road, continuing over bridge to join A19 Northbound (5.704 mls). Proceed north on A19 to finish at 3rd grating from north end of lay-by on A19, approx 0.75 mls south of Crathorne/Picton Road Bridge over A19. (10.00 mls).

<u>Awards</u>: In an experiment to address rising costs of time trialing, with a reduced entry fee, there are no prizes.

Results: With no result board, all results will be posted onto the Cycling Time Trials website and the Cycling Time trials – Teesside Facebook page.

2021 Teesside District Road Bike Specification

To compete in the 2021 road bike category in any of the Teesside District open event, the following specification is appropriate to the conditions of inclusion:

Signing On:

1. When signing on please tick the road bike column to indicate that you are to compete on a road bike.

The Rider:

- 1. No time trial style pointy helmets (including Kask Bambino), or helmets with built in visors are to be worn.
- 2. Use of skinsuit is permitted
- 3. No riding with elbows or forearms on the handlebars (known as "puppy paws"). If witnessed, the competitor may be disqualified.

The Machine:

- 1. The frame should be constructed in the traditional pattern, i.e. built around a main triangle. Multi geared bikes as well as fixed wheel machines are permitted.
- No time trial style or triathlon forward extension bars with or without elbow pads will be used.
- 3. Wheels should be of a spoked construction, with a minimum of 12 spokes and a maximum depth of 65mm.

Please apply the spirit of the road bike competition in your equipment choice. Non-compliance with any of the above (albeit for point 3 in rider section) will result in the competitor being excluded from the road bike category.
