Headquarters: In a change from the normal headquarters used for this course/event, the new venue is: **KIRKLEVINGTON VILLAGE HALL, Forest Lane, Kirklevington, Yarm TS15 9LQ.** This hall is approx. 1.75miles north of the start on the A67 Yarm/Thirsk road. If approaching from South, take the slip road onto A67, signed Yarm. (just past 25 finish point) After approx. 1mile, turn left onto Forest Lane, adjacent to CROWN public house and the hall is approx. 300yds on left. There is very limited parking at the hall and in the village. There is a 25 parking nearby at the entrance to St Martin's Green. The Hall will be open from 7am.

PLEASE, when parking, please respect the residents. If parking at Crathorne, close to the start, please do not park in Crathorne village during the event. there is ample parking on grass verges on road leading to the Rountons. wherever possible, please park to the west of bridge over A19.

SIGNING ON SHEET & BODY NUMBERS will be at the HQ. Please return number after your ride & sign out. **No sign out = DNF**

Please Note: There will be no pusher off for this event.

IF YOU ARE FEELING UNWELL BEFORE THE EVENT, PLEASE DO NOT TRAVEL TO THE EVENT

Course: T252/3 : Start at de-restriction sign at south end of Crathorne on old A19 (5 yds south of farm entrance) and proceed onto A19 southbound. Continue on A19 to bear left off A19 signed Knayton ¼ ml, Borrowby 1¼ ml, (12.16mls) Proceed up slip road to turn left over bridge crossing A19, to crossroads, where left to rejoin A19 northbound. Continue northwards to finish at end of footpath, just prior to bridge over A19 (Crathorne/Rounton Road) (25.00 mls)

CONDITIONS SPECIFIC TO THIS EVENT

There is no road bike category in this championship, as there was a separate Teesside road bike championship organized by Stockton Wheelers CC earlier in the season.

2022 TEESSIDE GUIDELINES

- Numbers, to be collected from & returned to the Headquarters, where the signing in and out sheet will be located. **Any additional hazards identified on the day will be advised on a notice adjacent to the signing in/out sheet.**
- No cars other than the event officials to be parked at the start or finish.
- No U turns in sight of the start.
- Riders are not to warm up on any part of the course, whilst an event is being held
- No turbo trainers are to be used for warming up within 100 metres of inhabited properties.

WHEN FIXING YOUR NUMBER VIA THE PINS PROVIDED OR BY USE OF THE INTEGRAL POCKETS IN YOUR SKINSUIT, PLEASE DO NOT FOLD THE NUMBERS, AS THIS CAUSES DAMAGE TO THE NUMBERS AND SHORTENS THEIR LIFE SPAN. IT ALSO CONTRAVENES THE CTT REGULATIONS TO DO SO. IN ADDITION, AS A CONTRIBUTING SAFETY FEATURE, THE FULL NUMBER ON SHOW ACTS AS AN 8 INCH FLUORESCENT SIGN TO OTHER ROAD USERS APPROACHING FROM THE REAR THAT THERE IS A RIDER AHEAD.

Results will be posted on the Cycling Time Trials website as soon as possible after the finish of the event.

Thank you to all the riders who stayed with the event and to those new to the event who have replaced the 26 riders who could not make the new date. Lets hope for a better and drier day than on the day of the July Event. Thanks also go to Cleveland Wheelers who agreed for this event to go ahead on the same day as their hill climb.
