Course

Course: Start on Sir William Hill Road at Adlington Lane, opposite Fire Hydrant sign near wall and FH cover in road. Row of 3 cottages stand back off road above. Proceed uphill, passing Bank Top Lane (no through road) on left and then lane to Leam on right-hand side. Finish at large stone gatepost on right, near wooden fingerpost 'Public FP' as road takes a sharp left-hand bend towards Eyam. Rough track, continuation of Sir William Hill Road is forward.

HQ and Parking

The HQ is at the Sir William Hotel (which is mainly a pub), right at the bottom of the climb. Numbers will be available at the HQ. There is parking available at the pub, and also at the cricket pavilion (entrance at the traffic lights in the middle of the village). Please park considerately. Please don't park on Sir William Hill during the event – although there is parking available at the beginning of the rough road continuation of Sir William Hill just after the finish line.

Please note

Keep your head up while riding and obey the rules of the road. Remember that marshals are there to warn traffic, not to stop it. Take responsibility for your own riding at all times. Descend carefully. No warming up on the course once the event has begun. No U turns within sight of the start or finish.

REMEMBER TO SIGN OFF AFTER YOU HAVE FINISHED, WHEN YOU RETURN YOUR NUMBER. It's a DQ if you don't! Cycling Time Trials require that you wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets approved safety standards.

Also, YOUR CYCLE MUST HAVE A WORKING FRONT and REAR LIGHT FITTED, NO LIGHTS NO RIDE!

If in doubt, see CTT regs 14,15 and 16. These regulations will apply on the day.

This event may be subject to doping control. Race numbers required for doping control will be displayed at the HQ.

And finally...

Unfortunately (for me), one of my best friends decided to get married on the same day as the Sir William Hill Climb! So I (Nick) won't be in Grindleford on the day of the race. Thanks very much for ex-Mam Nick Course Record holder Chris Dyke for agreeing to stand in for me.
