Morning Event : Riber Road First man off 10.01

COURSE, AHC/1: Riber Road

Start in the access lay-by to St. Giles Primary School, Starkholmes Road, Matlock. [GR SK301595]. Proceed up Starkholmes Road, fork left up Riber Road. Take the first right up the hill and then through the S-bend to finish 15m past the steep hill sign at the top of the hill.

Distance: 1.196Km. Course record, D Clarke 3-21.6

Gradients: 1st. 0.4Km 9%, next 0.15Km 0%, 0.64Km 14% (max 25%) and the final 0.01Km 0%

Riber Event HQ.

The event HQ is Starkholmes Village Hall which is about 0.4km from the start up the hill.

COURSE, AHC/6: Bank Road

Start at the bus shelter just above Imperial Road, Matlock. Climb up Bank Road and continue into Rutland Street to finish by the wall just above Matlock Green Garage, just before the junction with Wellington Street and the triangle at this junction.

Distance : 700 yards

Gradient : Average 12% maximum 25%

Bank Road Event HQ.

The event HQ is Imperial Rooms, Imperial Road, Matlock. an old church opposite the large car park, at the foot of the hill. Most of the adjacent car parking is "pay and display". However single yellow lines do not operate on Sundays. Please be aware that traffic wardens are very active in Matlock at weekends so park sensibly.

Covid-19 Instructions

Due to Covid-19 restrictions there will be no refreshments so please come prepared with water etc for the event. There are many cafes in Matlock. Results will be circulated and prizes sent out by post as soon as possible after the events.

Riders should pack away and then leave the area as soon as possible after the event and avoid congregating at the HQ and finish.

Competitors must sign out at the end of each event and leave their number in the bucket. Failure to do so will result in a DNF. Signing onsheets and the numbers will be close to the HQs

The event is being delivered in compliance with Government restrictions and the current CTT Covid-19 (24/07/20)

Competitors should plan to arrive about 30 minutes before their start time to allow time to sign on, warm up and get to the start. Parking is limited for the Ribber climb. There are many car parks in Matlock.

Competitors must not attend if they feel ill in any way or if family members have any symptoms.

Warming up should be individually conducted on a road, by yourself, once the events have started.

Toilets are available in both HQs on a one person at a time basis. Please queue sensibly, socially distanced. No changing in the HQ Masks must be worn in the HQs. There are toilets in the park in Matlock.

No pushing off and no catchers at the top.

Remember hard shell helmets must be worn if you are a juvenile or a junior.

Remember to bring pins and a pen.

It is now compulsory that a working rear light is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road vehicles and is active while the machine is in use.
