CTT Regs: Working, and switched on, front and rear lights, and a helmet, are mandatory in all CTT events.

Parking – Please use the car park at the Village Hall and overspill field, be aware this is a residential area & many will (sensibly!) be up to various activities under the duvet. So please keep the noise levels down, no noisy turbos please. No parking in the vicinity of Greatham Church.

To the Start: Turn left outside of the Village Hall and continue to the end of the road where turn right on to the A325 roundabout where take the 2nd exit towards the A3. When you reach the roundabout on top of the A3 go straight over to the 'holding area' above the A3 and 50 meters from the start. There is no need to go back & forth to the start as we do not move it once the event has started.

When you have finished, don't sit up, you are still in "live" traffic, take care coming up to the Ham Barn roundabout and take the third exit towards Greatham and HQ. You will arrive at the village hall from the opposite direction.

Once you have finished your ride you will be asked to return your number & sign out, back at the HQ. Please stay for a quick presentation which will take place shortly after the last rider has finished (and returned their number!).

Please do not ask the Timekeepers where the course goes, they time it, not ride it.

Procedure During the Event:

If caught, ease back; do not take pace on the wheel of the rider who caught you.

If passing a rider, please make sure the effort is enough to pass completely.

Look where you are going, keep your head up & please don't hog the carriageway, keep to the inside lane at all times, sometimes cars stop on the carriageway, honest!

IN TH INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters require you to wear a HARD-SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. It is also <u>compulsory</u> that WORKING FRONT & REAR LIGHTS, either flashing or constant, are fitted to the machine in a position visible to road users and are active while the machine is in use at all times.

Don't Forget You Need Front & Rear Lights

Do not park near the start on the verges, entrance to the ranges, or the depot as this is MOD land, and it is likely that you will be clamped or worse as well as a DQ!

Start on the Hard shoulder on the southbound slip road to the A3 at Longmoor (A325) three metres from the start of the Armco barrier. Proceed to the slip road onto the southbound A3 towards Petersfield'


Take 2nd Exit and continue on A3 until reaching the exit slip road signposted Liss (1/2 mile past the lay-by) where take this Exit Slip Road to the Princes Bridge RAB (SU 770270). Take 2nd Exit and then bear RIGHT following the sign A3 Guildford to cross Prince's Bridge Flyover where **TURN** (3.08 Miles) onto & rejoin A3 towards London Guildford. Continue along A3 to Ham Barn Roundabout, **Approaching Ham Barn Roundabout stay in the middle lane** & take 2nd Exit (5 miles).

Proceed passing turnings for the (1) A325 (Farnham) (2) Griggs Green, at the third turning (10.2 miles) take the left turn signposted Haslemere / Liphook, and continue over the flyover taking the left turn onto the slip road to rejoin the A3 in a southerly direction (signposted Petersfield / Portsmouth).

Retrace along A3 southbound towards the Ham Barn Roundabout passing the Griggs Green turning (12.2 mile) pass the starting area at Longmoor to finish at the entrance on the lay-by approximately 600 yards north of Ham Barn roundabout (15 miles).
