Cycling to the event

There will be a unique prize to every rider who arrives at the course under their own power, on their bike. It will fit in a jersey pocket or can be eaten before leaving. The prize will be available when you return your number.

Warming up

Riders may wish to use the A623, Baslow Rd between Calver and Baslow for warming up.

Course Description

Start on A623 in Stoney Middleton opposite Lamp Post 76262 (adjacent to waste ground parking). Proceed westwards up Middleton Dale, past B6465 junction (3.12 miles). Left turn onto Mires Lane (signposted 'Litton, Cressbrook') (3.43 miles). Through Litton to B6049 (4.94 miles). Left onto B6049. Left turn, signposted 'Priestcliffe' (8.00 miles). Left onto A6 (8.68 miles), down Taddington Dale and past Buxton Road turn into Ashford in the Water (12.86). Left onto A6020 (13.36 miles). At T1 left onto B6001 (15.33 miles). Through Hassop to finish on brow of hill opposite Bramley Lane (17.62 miles)

Special Covid 19 guidance:

- Any rider, supporter or member of the organising team who believes they could be demonstrating symptoms of Covid 19, are currently in a vulnerable group required to self isolate, or have been told to self-isolate should not attend the event.
- Riders are strongly encouraged not to attend with any supporters unless necessary.
- Face masks should be brought and used by riders when signing on/off. Those requiring safety pins for their numbers should bring their own. After completing, used numbers should be placed in the detergent filled bucket at the signing-on/off HQ.
- Riders and any supporters should not socialise with others either before the event or stay around the HQ table: riders should arrive in sufficient time to sign on, compete. Riders should leave the signing-off point as soon as they have returned their number. No results will be provided at the event but will appear by way of the CTT Website after the event.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD-SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets.

It is **compulsory** that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

Please consider the use of a front light - sections of the course have dense tree canopy cover, particularly the final 2 miles, and will be quite dark even if the sun is shining!

Any competitor making a "U" turn in the vicinity of the start or finish will be disqualified from the event.

Riders must not ride with their head down - you are riding on public roads, please take care.

Please remember that you are now required to sign off after you have finished - failure to do so will result in DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control. It is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for any Doping Control will be displayed at the signing on/ off point. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If your number is displayed you are required to report to Doping Control, which will be nearby, after finishing and without delay.

All competitors are now required **personally** to sign the signing out sheet when returning their number. Failure to do will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF.

Prize List

Athlete prize open to riders using standard road bikes, bars & helmet; no disc wheels, aero helmet, TT bars or clip-on tri-bars, max rim depth of 50mm. Please mark the signing -on sheet with an A and inform the timekeeper at the start that you wish to compete for the athlete category. Eligibility at timekeeper's discretion.
