Headquarters

HEADQUARTERS and PARKING – Open from 06:30 hrs.

Event Headquarters is the Dalton Village Hall, Willow Bridge Lane, Dalton, near Topcliffe, YO7 3BN. The village lies to the south of the Thirsk by-pass. Access the village via the A168 junction at Topcliffe, or from A19, south of Thirsk. Turn into either Moor End Lane (signed Dalton) or Low Lane (signed Sessay, Dalton). Body-numbers, signing-on sheets, result board and refreshments will be located here. Please return your numbers after your ride. Showers are available. Please park sensibly, and do not block entrance to rear car-park.

Do not park in front of the new houses opposite the HQ, and keep noise to a minimum.

SHOE-PLATES ARE NOT TO BE WORN IN MAIN HALL

Please respect the neighbourhood

Route from HQ to start

It is approx. **2 miles from the HQ to the start**, so allow plenty of time to get there. From HQ turn right on Willow Bridge Lane, then next right, through centre of village towards Topcliffe. On reaching slip-road from A168 to Topcliffe, keep left, under dual carriageway. Start is on your right just beyond slip-road to A168/A19 Northbound. Take care not to impede riders on the slip-road under the fly-over who may be just about to turn right to start their second lap. **After finishing** stay on the slip-road as far as the turning to your left for Dalton, and Hessay. Turn off here to retrace your outward route, back to the HQ.

Course details

COURSE V236/1

Topcliffe/A168/A19/South Kilvington x 2.

START at east end of High Street, Topcliffe, at western edge of drain cover, just east of gateway to field at start of slip road to A168 northbound carriageway.

BEAR LEFT up slip road to join A168 dual carriageway.

CONTINUE on A168/A19 to slip road sign-posted A168 Northallerton (5.838 mls).

BEAR LEFT down slip road to T-junction (6.167 mls).

TURN LEFT to South Kilvington TI.

ENCIRCLE ISLAND, continue under A19 dual carriageway, bearing LEFT to join A19

southbound carriageway (6.663 mls).

CONTINUE on A19/A168 to slip road sign-posted A167 Topcliffe (12.226 mls).

BEAR LEFT onto slip road and continue under dual carriageway, to **TURN RIGHT (CARE)** (12.750 mls) onto slip road to A168 northbound carriageway.

REPEAT CIRCUIT

Join A168 (13.128 mls)

Start of slip road to South Kilvington (18.553 mls)

Rejoin A19 southbound (19.377 mls)

Start of slip road to Topcliffe (24.940 mls)

Bear left onto slip-road, to **FINISH** at eastern gate post of second gateway to field from the slip-road (25.00 mls).

As this course covers 2 laps, there will be some over-lapping of riders. When joining the slip-road from the A168 towards Topcliffe at the end of your 1st circuit, continue under the dual carriageway to turn right to start the 2nd circuit. **DO NOT** follow a rider in front of you who turns off to the left – they may have just finished the event (end of 2nd lap) and be returning to the HQ.

PLEASE NOTE: The Highways Agency do not permit the placing of signs, or marshals on the dual carriageway. Marshals & signs will be positioned as near to the junctions as is possible. Marshals are only to indicate your direction, and not to control traffic in your favour. At each junction it is your responsibility to ensure that it is safe to proceed. Keep your heads up, and keep to the left of the carriageway

Local regulations

LIGHTS & HELMETS

YOU MUST USE FUNCTIONING FRONT AND REAR LIGHTS - BOTH MUST BE SWITCHED ON WHEN YOU START - THIS WILL BE CHECKED ON THE START LINE

CYCLING TIMETRIALS, and the Event Promoters insist that you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

RIDERS' BODY NUMBERS

IN THE INTERESTS OF RIDER SAFETY, AS WELL AS VISIBILTY FOR TIMEKEEPERS & MARSHALS, NUMBERS SHOULD BE CENTRALLY POSITIONED ON SHORTS FROM WAIST DOWNWARDS TO BE VISIBLE IN RIDING POSITION – CTT Regulation 16 - P327 of current handbook. RIDERS WITH IMPROPERLY POSITIONED NUMBERS, OR NUMBERS FOLDED TO REDUCE THE SIZE, WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO START UNTIL NUMBER IS PROPERLY AFFIXED

Please do not warm up on the course once the first rider has started.

If using the A168 towards Dishforth, it is approx. 3 miles to the first exit. The slip-road to Topcliffe on the return leg from Dishforth brings you out opposite the start.

A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
