Bentley Memorial Hall, Hole Ln, Bentley, Farnham GU10 5LP

Route from HQ to start

Allow 15mins to get to the start line. Take a right on exiting the village hall car park and then an immediate left at the crossroads. Continue on the road (London Road) and you will enter a slip junction for the A31. The start line is on the opposite side of the carriageway when you reach the A31. To get to the start line, proceed on the A31 to the Coxbridge roundabout (approx 2mi) and come back on the other side of the carriageway. There are small junctions that can be used to make U-turns on the A31 but the safer route is as described.

Course details

Start at a point in the lead out onto the A31, from the lay-by on the south side at the start of the Bentley by-pass approximately 800 yards west of The Bull public house on the north side of the A31, 10 yards short of the last road drain at the lay-by exit (western end) Join the A31 (care) and proceed along the Bentley by-pass through Froyle and Neatham to the Holybourne roundabout (Turn) Circle the roundabout and take the third exit back onto the A31 to retrace, going through Froyle and along the Bentley by-pass to continue past the Bull to the Farnham roundabout at the junction with the A325 (Turn) Circle the roundabout and take the fourth exit back onto the A31 to retrace past the start point (14.294 miles) to go along the Bentley by-pass to the Holybourne roundabout (Turn) Circle the roundabout and take the third exit back onto the A31 to retrace, going through Froyle and along the Bentley by-pass to continue past the Bull (24.405 miles) to a point 70 yards beyond the county boundary line and 23 yards beyond the start of a tarmac path on the north side where finish.

Local regulations

Bentley Village Hall Instructions;

No cleats or bikes in the hall.

Those attending are to utilise the car park to the maximum and then overspill along the right-hand side of River Road, heading south towards Bentley Station. Park on the Grass verge, and then onto the bridge over the A31. However, please do not obstruct the pavement or the Bus Stop. Please do not park on the left-hand side of the road and block or obstruct the entrance to Doctors Field. Residents have difficulty in seeing oncoming traffic. Also, please do not park on Hole Lane, on any of the residential roads, or along London Road as such parking very quickly snarls up the traffic in the village. Always ensure sightlines near the cross roads are not obstructed. We have had several accidents here.

NOTES TO COMPETITORS:

- 17. Signing-on Sheet and Signing-out Sheet
- (a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number.
- (b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race

number(s); and (ii) sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
