Headquarters

Layby on the road to Sizergh Castle

Route from HQ to start

return to A590, turn left and around Brettagh Holt Roundabout to proceed towards Barrow, start in bus stop layby 200 meters up the A590

Course details

START at large sign (Levens Village/ Grange/ Newby Bridge) at west end of lay-by on A590 which is immediately east of Force Lane near junction with A6 road to Levens Bridge. Proceed in a westerly direction along A590 to Meathop Roundabout (5.57 miles) where take the first exit on to the B5277 to Lindale village where encircle Mini-Roundabout (6.86 miles). Retrace along the B5277 to Meathop Roundabout (8.08 miles) and take the second exit along the A590. Continue in an easterly direction along the A590 (The overhead bridge near Levens turn off is half distance) to the Roundabout near Sedgwick (14.18 miles). Encircle, taking the 4th exit along the A590 passing through the starting point (14.62 miles) and continue in a westerly direction to Meathop Roundabout (20.26 miles) where on this second occasion encircle and retrace along the A590. FINISH at white line 15 yards past 'A6' sign on slip road to the A6 road approximately 140 yards south-west of junction with the Levens Bridge to Levens village road (25 miles).

Local regulations

Cycling Time Trials – North D.C. 2022 – Local Regulations L1015, L2524, L308

The following Local Regulations have been approved by the National Committee in accordance with Regulation 38 Any breaches may lead to disciplinary action being taken.

CTT Regulation 14 Competitors Machine – FRONT WHITE LIGHT & REAR RED LIGHT.

NO COMPETITOR shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine **A WORKING FRONT WHITE LIGHT**, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users. **A WORKING REAR RED LIGHT** must be affixed to the rear of the machine, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users

Regulation 17: Signing-on Sheet and Signing-Out Sheet:

- a. The Competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official Signing-on Sheet when collecting their number.
- b. In Type A events a competitor must return to the events HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the even and must (i) return their number and (ii) sign the official Signing–Out Sheet

Local Reg No 5

During the event, warming-up on the course is not permitted.

Competitors must not ride past the timekeepers, except when actually competing.

Local Reg No 6

Any competitor making a 'U' turn in the vicinity of the start or finish will be disqualified from the event

Local Reg No 12

No parking on the car park or on the frontage of the Strickland Arms.

Local Reg No 15

Riders must keep to the left-hand side of the road except when overtaking. Failure to comply with the above may lead to disqualification.

ALL the ABOVE to be included on the START SHEET

IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE

Riders must give their number at the finish and elsewhere on the course if requested.

Riders must NOT STAND in the road at the start or finish. (This constitutes obstruction and is a breach of Regulations).

Riders must NOT ride with their heads down.

Helmets:

All competitors **MUST** wear a HELMET of HARD/SOFT SHELL construction that conforms to a recognised Standard (See Regulation 15).

NOTE - ALL of the above MUST be included on the start sheet for the riders' information.

The following local regulations / recommendations / information applies to

the event promoters.

Local Reg No 7

The start sheet must include the designated point for the completion of the Signing on and Signing-Out sheet, receiving any further instructions and the collection of numbers [see Regulation No 27(e)(xi) and 27(h)(i)]

Local Reg No 11

For all events in the North District at least 50% of the entry fees (less levies) must be allocated to awards.

In Addition to the above

A copy of the warning sign 'Head Down' should be displayed at event H.Q. or start.

Safety: In the interests of safety, marshals should wear fluorescent clothing.

Risk Assessment: The event must comply with the Risk Assessment relevant to the course being used, also any instructions/warnings etc. for the rider on the Risk Assessment must be included on the start sheet.

'Event Safety Form' to be completed and returned to the Assistant Sec for Open Events with the copy of the result sheet.

Course: The course details on Police Forms and Start Sheets must be identical to the details as enclosed.

Event Officials: A competent person must be appointed as the “Start Line Official” who will “manage” the start line and assist the timekeeper.

The following recommendations should also be adopted by event promoters

- 1 All timekeepers should be offered a fee of not less than £20.00.
- 2 The first rider off should be a member of the promoting club.

Note - A general guide to the duties of a promoting secretary are given on page 89 of the current handbook, you will also be issued with a copy and a check list.

Although you should have studied and generally understood C.T.T. Rules and Regulations, in particular the following are brought to your attention-

NOTES TO COMPETITORS:

17. Signing-on Sheet and Signing-out Sheet

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s); and (ii) sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
