Competitors must exercise extra care when joining the A24 just after start and at all roundabouts.

No times will be given at the Finish

After finishing Competitors MUST continue to North Holmwood RBT taking the appropriate exit to return to Event HQ.

GUIDANCE NOTES for Event Promoters

Promoters should refer to the GENERIC Risk Assessment and check that all measure to reduce risk have been covered.

Promoters should also complete a SPECIFIC Risk Assessment to identify any additional risks shortly before the event. Contacting

the Highways Authority and briefing Competitors at the Signing On Point if necessary. On the day after the event, the Specific

Risk Assessment Sheet/s must be posted to the London South Assistant Secretary (Courses) - see details in CTT Handbook.

Promoters should also be familiar with CTT Regulations and,in particular , the sections "Duties of Promoting Secretaries"

and "Abandonment or Postponement of Events" as published in the current CTT Handbook.

Promoters should keep the Entry Forms, Signing On Sheets and Check Cards for one year after the event if there has been no

incident in connection with the event and for three years if there has been an incident.

Please ensure we give a great account of ourselves, our sport and the cycling community as we travel to and from HQ and the start line. I know you will.

SAFETY

- Riders are requested not to warm up on the course after the event has started.
- Details of any additional hazards will be displayed at the HQ, all riders must read these details when they sign on.
- Riders must exercise extra care when joining the A24 just after the start and at all roundabouts.
- CTT regulations require the use of a helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards for all competitors
- CTT Regulations now require that no competitor shall be permitted to start unless they have affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, and to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that are illuminated and positioned to be clearly visible to other road users.
- London South DC Regulation: No vehicles, except those of the timekeepers and event officials shall be parked in the vicinity of the start and finish areas.
- London South DC strongly recommend that riders do not wear black or dark clothing during any event held on the public road.
- Marshalls will be stationed around the course to ensure riders comply with the above requirements.
- No time may be recorded if number is not correctly positioned
- Riders must not use ANY audio equipment except prescribed hearing aids.
- Please note that all riders are required to sign out on the signing in/out sheet before leaving the HQ. Failure to do will result in a rider being recorded as DNF

NOTES TO COMPETITORS:

17. Signing-on Sheet and Signing-out Sheet

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s); and (ii) sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
